



Stockland Lovell Camp **Fri 3rd June – Sun 5th June 2022**

For those who have never taken their horse away to a weekend camp before this is a chance to experience expert tuition in a number of disciplines using excellent facilities with friends and fellow members. More details about Stockland Lovell itself can be viewed at <http://stocklandlovell.com>. Please note that although there is an excellent X-country course available this is weather dependant, if conditions dictate XC may have to be substituted with SJ in the arena – although this has not happened in previous years.

We will have groups to cater for all abilities (and states of nervousness) so please don't feel you have to jump if you don't want to, it's all about having fun with your horse / pony and fellow riding club members and achieving your own personal goals. The camp is for members only over the age of 18 and with their own 3rd party insurance.

There will be 3 sessions of tuition per rider. You can request Flatwork / Polework, Flatwork / SJ /XC or SJ / 2 Flatwork Sessions so hopefully there will be something for everyone. **Please ensure your horse is fit enough for the weekend as they will work quite hard over the 3 sessions.**

When you are not enjoying a lesson you are free to go hacking around the grounds and there are also some excellent bridleways in the area. If you are riding on the XC course a hat without a peak, body protector and medical armband must be worn.

This year the accommodation will be in the log cabins which sleep 3/4. Please specify on your form who you would like to share with and I will do my best to facilitate this. You will need to bring a sleeping bag (or duvet if preferred) and pillows.

The price includes all meals including an evening meal on the day of arrival and lunch on the final day, 3 lessons from a qualified instructor and a stable for your horse with bedding and hay provided. You will need to bring hard feed for your horse, a water bucket and mucking out tools/wheelbarrow.

Option 1) 2 Nights – Arrive 5pm Fri 3rd - 1pm Sun 5th June - Tuition on 2 days - Max 20 Riders - £275

This figure includes a £10 contingency payment should we have less than 20 riders which will be refunded if all places are filled.

Option 2) 2 Nights - Arrive 5pm Fri 3rd - 1pm Sun 5th June - Hacking Only - £215

Option 3) 2 Nights - Arrive 5pm Fri 3rd - 1pm Sun 5th June - Non Riders staying in cabin/lorry - £150

Cost to bring a second horse for two nights is an additional £65

Please note – no dogs allowed on residential camp.

Stockland Lovell will require to see **all horse passports with up to date vaccination details and have a 6 month vaccination policy**. If you do not bring this with you your horse will not be allowed on site. You will also need to have your own 3rd party insurance cover.

Please complete a booking form along with a medical form and return with your deposit to reserve your place. Ridden places are limited to 20, if we are oversubscribed unsuccessful applicants will go onto a waiting list.
